

## **Information about FoBSP Trustees and Committee**

### **Paul Tilzey – Chairman**

Paul is known to many people in Bude as he was for many years a teacher of maths at Budehaven School. He is a long-standing member of Bude and Stratton Town Council and was previously Chairman of the town's Tourist Board. He was one of the original founders of FoBSP and has stood as its Chair of FoBSP since its inception in 2011.

### **Martyn Holehouse – Vice-Chairman**
